ELDER RETREAT SUMMARY

The Session met January 10-11 for a retreat, though the snow meant we could not meet at Chamberlain Elementary! On Friday we elected Tara Markham as president of the corporation; re-elected Rose Ann Walker as clerk, Greg and Terri Rader as co-treasurers, and Leslie Bremar as asst. treasurer. We also approved communion dates for 2025, heard a report on the continuing progress toward moving Common Grounds into the house next door, and were briefed by Kathy Kruk on the changes coming to Presbytery — a new staffing model, new committee structure, and a focus on relationships, providing resources, and leadership development.

On Saturday we heard a final report from the Thriving Congregations group and their work to develop a ministry with senior adults and partner with Chamberlain Elementary. We also drafted people to serve on ministry teams; evaluated 2024 and our ministry in the community; and dreamed a little about what we might do in 2025. We also passed a budget for 2025 that includes a 3% raise for staff in response to inflation.

There will be a meeting of the congregation on January 26 to present the budget, vote on changes to the terms of Todd's call, and share MT reports.

Solar Report

From July through December, our solar panels produced almost 5.4 MWh of electricity, the equivalent of planting 64 trees!

While there have been many days in January when the panels were covered with snow, we've still produced 237 kWh of power, enough to charge 20,500 phones!

On the 15th we submitted the paperwork for \$31,659 in grants under the Inflation Reduction Act.

February 2: Fourth Sunday after Epiphany

Read Jeremiah 1:4-10

God chose Jeremiah to be God's messenger, to speak God's word. Though Jeremiah insisted that he was too young and didn't know how, God promised to go with him and give him the words to speak. What has God called you to say about God to others? What excuses keep you from speaking with others about God?

February 9: Fifth Sunday after Epiphany

Read Luke 5:1-11

When Jesus called his first disciples, they were washing their nets after a long night of fishing when they caught nothing. Jesus invited them to follow him, and they did so, leaving everything behind them. We, too, have been called to follow Jesus. What did you, might you, have to leave behind to follow?

February 16: Sixth Sunday after Epiphany Read Luke 6:17-19

Crowds of people came to hear Jesus, hoping that he would heal them, and Jesus did so. How has Jesus healed you? How might you help share Jesus' healing ministry this week?

February 23: Seventh Sunday after Epiphany Read Luke 6:27-38

Do you have any "enemies"? How do you treat them? Jesus taught those who would listen to him to love their enemies and do good to those that hate them. Imagine what it would be like in our schools, workplaces, homes, communities, nation, and world if we did so. Reach out to an "enemy" with love this week.
